DAAD Science Slam 2015 Entertaining Science in 8 Minutes

Share your research project - Win great prizes!

Science Slams give scientists the opportunity to go on stage and present their own field of research and academic projects in a short and entertaining way to a non-specialist audience.

How does it work?

You have **8 minutes** to enthuse the jury and audience. The key to success is offering an entertaining and comprehensible presentation **in English** that inspires the audience and excites them for the scientific projects. Scientific accuracy, of course, is necessary, but any presentation format is acceptable: you can give an amusing power point presentation, use props or conduct a live-experiment, even singing is an option.

Who can participate?

The DAAD Science Slam is open to "ideally" young Bachelor, Master and PhD students and scientists from all disciplines. The contestants must present their own research and academic project. No matter if it is an interesting master thesis, a fascinating doctoral dissertation or a current research project that is worth sharing, every scientific project in every field of science is welcome.

The contestants have the chance to win material prizes worth up to 500 USD.

In a pre-selection, we will choose up to 7 contestants on the basis of the applications who have the chance to present their research in front of the audience and the jury on **June 10th 2016**. All applicants will receive a feedback, latest May 6th 2016.
